## myStudent Parent Portal



Our new grade book and attendance platform, myStudent, is available for parents to login for the 2016-17 school year. This portal will allow you to monitor your child's progress and enhance communication and involvement in your child's education. The myStudent platform which includes a parent portal for you to view important information about your child. As a part of this portal, there is a tab on the left navigation panel called Child Info. Under this tab, there will be another tab called Local Assessments. Results from the Quarterly Checks will be uploaded to this tab each quarter that Quarterly Checks are administered. For students who take a District Final, these results will also be reported in this area.


any items available to add to our treasure box, please send the items with your students in a bag marked for the art room. I truly appreciate the support!
