



Success Plan at a Glance 2022-23

Goal

1

By May 2023, students will have mastery of the BEST standards for Math and proficiently apply mathematical understanding with 75% proficiency on State EOY assessments.

- All instructional staff will engage in regularly scheduled professional learning opportunities around the BEST Standards for Math
- Staff will follow set math pacing and utilize the Eureka & Zearn resources to teach the grade-level mathematical concepts to the rigor of the standards
- All students will be given extensive opportunities to practice grade-level exercises through Zearn & with targeted teacher supports
- All students will engage in mathematical discussions by sharing their thinking around grade-level concepts and analyzing peer thinking/explanations related to math (Core Actions 3C & 3D)

Goal

2

By May 2023, students will demonstrate Academic & Social Behavior competence by developing positive relationships with peers and adults across campus.

- Class meetings will be conducted a minimum of 3x's/weekly in all classes
- Student groups and mentoring programs will be developed to target social needs
- Students will engage in weekly Second-Step pro-social lessons
- Inner Explorer resources will be utilized weekly in all classrooms to address self-regulation
- Before and after school clubs will be established to bolster student engagement and feelings of social belongingness
- Parent-Student-Teacher conferences will take place 1x/semester to work collaboratively and build student awareness of areas for growth

Goal

3

Within the ELA block, differentiation, centers, and strategic groupings will be implemented based on student data/targeted needs at minimum 2x's per week in all classrooms.

- Differentiated centers will be utilized during the ELA block
- Targeted student groups will meet within the ELA block for scaffolded support or extension
- Students will be monitored regularly, and groups adjusted based on data/needs
